REQUEST FOR THE PROVISION OF SECURITY GUARDING SERVICES FOR A PERIOD OF THIRTY-SIX (36) MONTHS

Emalahleni Local Municipality hereby invites service providers for the provision of security guarding services for a period of thirty-six (36) months.

Tender documents with full specifications will be made available and can be obtained from www.emalahleni.gov.za or www.etenders.gov.za as from **Wednesday, 15 June 2022**.

A compulsory briefing will not be conducted for this tender. Bidders may send electronic mails for any enquiries related to this bid.

The closing time for receipt of tenders is **11:00 on Friday, 15 July 2022**. Telegraphic, telephonic, telex, facsimile, e-mail, unmarked and **late tenders** will under no circumstances be considered and accepted. The tender box will be emptied just after closing time on the closing date. The register for all bids received may be requested thereafter and will furthermore be published on the municipal website.

Couriered documents should be delivered at the first floor, Supply Chain Management Offices at the aforementioned address **by no later than 11h00 on 15 July 2022**. The envelope must be endorsed with number, title and closing date as indicated above.

A preferential point system shall apply whereby a contract will be allocated to a tenderer in accordance with the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act, Act No. 5 of 2000 and as defined in the Conditions of Tender in the tender document, read in conjunction with the Supply Chain Management Policy of Emalahleni Local Municipality where **90** points will be allocated in respect of price and **10** points in respect of B-BBEE Status Level of Contribution.

No awards will be made to a person:

- Who is not registered on the **Central Supplier Database (CSD)**;
- Who is in the service of the state;
- If that person is not a natural person, of which any director, manager, principal shareholder or stakeholder is a person in the service of the state; and/or
- who is an advisor or consultant contracted with the municipality or municipal entity.

The municipality reserves the right to withdraw any invitation to tender and/or to re-advertise or to reject any tender or to accept a part of it. The municipality does not bind itself to accepting the lowest.
